TIMELINE

Now – March 29: entry forms, images, fees accepted.

Entry Deadline March 29 at end of day

April 1: work juried and notified of acceptance status

April 4 & 5: art drop off dates

April 10 - June 7: exhibit dates

April 19 @ 5:30 PM: Opening Reception & Awards Ceremony

June 10, 11, 13, 14: art pick up dates

CRITERIA

1. All media and subject matter acceptable. But be aware – this show will be open to all ages at all times.
2. All entries must have been shot and edited by the artist within the last two (2) years.
3. You may enter up to 10 photographs (fees are \$10 per digital entry and \$5 per film entry).
4. Professional and Amateur Divisions are in place for protection of amateur artists. Those who sell their work or take photos for profit qualify as professional. Amateurs may also compete in the Professional Division.
5. Entry form, fee(s), and digital image deadline is March 29, 2024.
6. Prints must be matted and/or framed and ready to hang for acceptance in show. Please see website for detailed instructions.

HOW TO ENTER

1. PAY: Using one of the following methods, pay entry fees for each piece, up to ten photographs (fee must be received for work to be juried)

2. Using the confirmation email received after paying, click the link to fill out the digital entry form and submit. **Registration is not complete until both payment and entry forms are received.**

JURY & JUDGING PROCESS

Delivered works will be juried to ensure work meets all criteria. Notice of acceptance status will be by April 1. Accepted works will be displayed for the duration of the exhibit and may not be removed for any reason. Displayed entries will be judged by AACA host judge, TBA. Judging will be “blind,” meaning the artists’ names will be hidden. Prizes given include Best in Show, Professional 1st and 2nd, and Amateur 1st and 2nd. There will be several cash prizes given based on entries and fees collected.
